

COVID-19 Safe Practices and Guidelines When Working on an Allan Myers Job

As the impact from the coronavirus (COVID-19) continues around the world, Allan Myers would like to share information, guidance and policies that we have in place on our job sites, and in our offices and job trailers.

Access to Our Sites

- Please do not enter our job site, or have personal contact with our employees for at least 14 days, or until you are symptom free for 48 hours if you have:
 - Travelled internationally in the last 30 days
 - Have had close contact with someone who has travelled internationally in the last 30 days.
 - Had close contact with an confirmed positive case of COVID-19
 - Tested positive for COVID-19
 - Currently experiencing flu-like symptoms including: fever, cough or shortness of breath.

Social Distancing and Good Hygiene Practices

- Anyone entering our job sites, offices, or job trailers are expected to follow the good hygiene and social distancing practices listed below as per guidance from the CDC:
 - If you are experiencing flu-like symptoms, do not enter.
 - Avoid physical contact: do not shake hands
 - Leave at least 6 feet of space between yourself and others.
 - Wash your hands with soap and water, hand sanitizer or disinfectant wipes frequently throughout the day.
 - Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
 - Do not share objects like pens, pencils, or electronics.
 - Do not share personal protective equipment (PPE) like earmuffs, safety glasses, gloves or face shields.
 - If you cough or sneeze, do so into a disposable tissue or napkin and dispose of it immediately. If a tissue is not available, use the crook of your elbow and face away from people.
 - Limit time spent in a trailer or indoor space. When required, maintain appropriate distance from others.

As this is a dynamic situation, we will continue to closely monitor the situation and our policies and guidelines may change as the situation continues to evolve.
